TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

2. No request for inspection after submission of offer will be accepted.

3. The vendor must obtain an acknowledgment from Sh. Badr for having submitted his/her proposal.

5. The goods shall be handed over to the vendor who has submitted the highest offer for these goods. Subsequently, the Goods must be lifted within 5 working days from the date of confirmation of the disposal by Embassy of India, Riyadh.

6 In case the vendor with highest offer fails to honour the tender terms and conditions, then the vendor with second highest proposal will be allowed to lift the old goods.

7. The cost of lifting of old items shall be borne by the bidder. The Embassy takes no responsibility in this regard.
